NEBRASKA MILK PRODUCTION

LINCOLN, NE, April 21, 2015 -- Milk production in Nebraska during the January-March 2015 quarter totaled 311 million pounds, up 7 percent from the January-March quarter last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 55,000 head.
