NEBRASKA CHICKEN AND EGGS

LINCOLN, NE, January 22, 2016 – All layers in Nebraska during December 2015 totaled 7.54 million, down from 9.57 million the previous year, according to the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service.

Nebraska egg production during December totaled 164 million eggs, down from 244 million in 2014. December egg production per 100 layers was 2,175 eggs, compared to 2,549 eggs in 2014.
