MONTHLY NEBRASKA CHICKEN AND EGGS

LINCOLN, NE, March 22, 2016 – All layers in Nebraska during February 2016 totaled 8.56 million, down from 9.55 million the previous year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

Nebraska egg production during February totaled 192 million eggs, down from 220 million in 2015. February egg production per 100 layers was 2,244 eggs, compared to 2,303 eggs in 2015.
