MONTHLY NEBRASKA CHICKEN AND EGGS

Lincoln, NE – All layers in Nebraska during March 2016 totaled 8.74 million, down from 9.54 million the previous year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service.

Nebraska egg production during March totaled 220 million eggs, down from 241 million in 2015. March egg production per 100 layers was 2,517 eggs, compared to 2,525 eggs in 2015.
