NEBRASKA CATTLE ON FEED UP 3%

LINCOLN, Neb. July 22, 2022 - Nebraska feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.37 million cattle on feed on July 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up 3% from last year.

Placements during June totaled 405,000 head, down 2% from 2021.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of June totaled 545,000 head, down 2% from last year.

Other disappearance during June totaled 20,000 head, up 10,000 head from last year.
