NEBRASKA CATTLE ON FEED UP SLIGHTLY

LINCOLN, Neb. April 19, 2024 - Nebraska feedlots, with capacities of 1,000 or more head, contained 2.54 million cattle on feed on April 1, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. This inventory was up slightly from last year.

Placements during March totaled 450,000 head, down 6% from 2023.

Fed cattle marketings for the month of March totaled 460,000 head, down 2% from last year.

Other disappearance during March totaled 10,000 head, unchanged from last year.
