NEBRASKA MILK PRODUCTION

LINCOLN, Neb. October 19, 2018 - Milk production in Nebraska during the July-September 2018 quarter totaled 353 million pounds, down 2 percent from the July-September quarter last year, according to the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The average number of milk cows was 59,000 head, 1,000 head less than the same period last year.
