Weather Summary

Weather Report for Nevada for the week ending on Sunday, April 19, 2020:

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 11 degrees in Winnemucca to 50 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 61 degrees in Ely to 81 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for Nevada ranged from 0.01 inches in Elko, 0.05 inches in Winnemucca, 0.08 inches in Tonopah, and 0.68 inches in Ely.

Crops Summary

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 7.0 days. Topsoil Moisture: 5% Very Short, 15% Short, 75% Adequate, and 5% Surplus. Subsoil Moisture: 5% Very Short, 20% Short, 70% Adequate and 5% Surplus.
