## **Weather Summary**

The average lows for Nevada ranged from 9 degrees in Eureka to 46 degrees in Las Vegas. The average highs ranged from 61 degrees in Eureka to 78 degrees in Las Vegas. Precipitation for Nevada ranged from 0.03 inches in Elko, 0.16 inches in Reno, and 0.27 inches in Winnemucca.

## **Crops Summary**

Days Suitable for Fieldwork: 6.2 days. Topsoil Moisture: 15% very short, 30% short and 50% adequate, 5% surplus. Subsoil Moisture: 20% very short, 30% short, 45% adequate and 5% surplus. Pasture and Range Condition: 15% Very Poor, 20% Poor, 35% Fair, 30% Good.
