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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, August 21, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 18 percent very short, 28 percent short, 52 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 12 percent very short, 27 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.
