According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 4, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 36 percent short, 63 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 25 percent short, 75 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
