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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 4 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 18, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 13 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 38 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 5 percent short, 58 percent adequate, and 37 percent surplus.
