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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 30, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 5 percent short, 59 percent adequate, and 36 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 7 percent short, 72 percent adequate, and 20 percent surplus.
