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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 22, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 43 percent short, 48 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 24 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.
