According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, October 27, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 16 percent very short, 22 percent short, 62 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 16 percent very short, 11 percent short, 72 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.
