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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, November 10, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 5 percent very short, 23 percent short, 72 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 19 percent short, 77 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
