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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New England, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, November 24, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 28 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 29 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
