## April Milk Production in Vermont Unchanged

**Milk production** in Vermont during April 2015 totaled 222 million pounds, unchanged from April 2014, according to Gary Keough, State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New England Field Office.

**Production per cow** in the State averaged 1,695 pounds for April, unchanged from April 2014.

**The number of milk cows** on farms in the State was 131 thousand head, unchanged from April 2014, but down 1,000 head from March 2015.

**The average milk price** received by Vermont farmers in March 2015 at \$17.90 per hundredweight, is down \$0.40 from February 2015 and is down \$8.40 from March a year ago.
