February Milk Production in Vermont

Milk production in Vermont during February 2015 totaled 204 million pounds, unchanged from February 2014, according to Gary Keough, State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New England Field Office.

Production per cow in the State averaged 1,545 pounds for February, unchanged from February 2014.

The number of milk cows on farms in the State was 132 thousand head, unchanged from February 2014, and unchanged from January 2015.

The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in January 2015 at \$19.00 per hundredweight, is down \$3.60 from December 2014 and is down \$5.50 from January a year ago.
