July Milk Production Up In Vermont

Milk production in Vermont during July 2015 totaled 230 million pounds, up 0.9 percent from July 2014, according to Gary Keough, State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New England Field Office.

Production per cow averaged 1,740 pounds in June, 10 pounds more than July 2014.

The number of milk cows on farms in the State was 132 thousand head, unchanged from July 2014 and June 2015.

The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in June 2015 at \$18.20 per hundredweight, is up \$0.20 from May 2015 but down \$6.70 from June a year ago.
