

## 2017 Maine Wild Blueberry Production and Value Declines

CONCORD, NH --- Maine wild blueberry growers saw a decrease in value of the 2017 wild blueberry crop, according to Gary Keough, State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New England Field Office.

**MAINE WILD BLUEBERRIES: Utilized Production and Value, 2007 – 2017**



Total production dropped to 67.8 million pounds, down 33 percent from 2016 production. The price growers received for processing berries in 2017 averaged \$0.25 per pound, down \$0.02 from 2016. Value of production of 2017 wild blueberries is \$17.561 million, down 37 percent from the previous year.
