Milk production in **New York** during December 2017 totaled 1.22 billion pounds, down 2.2 percent from December 2016. The average milk price received by New York farmers in November 2017, at \$18.30 per hundredweight, is up \$0.10 from October 2017 and up \$0.50 from November a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during December 2017 totaled 916 million pounds, up 0.5 percent from December 2016. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in November 2017, at \$18.70 per hundredweight, is up \$0.10 from October 2017 and up \$1.00 from November a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during December 2017 totaled 227 million pounds, down 0.9 percent from December 2016. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in November 2017, at \$18.60 per hundredweight, is up \$0.10 from October 2017 and up \$0.40 from November a year ago.
