Milk production in **New York** during February 2018 totaled 1.13 billion pounds, down 2.3 percent from February 2017. The average milk price received by New York farmers in January 2018, at \$16.70 per hundredweight, is down \$1.00 from December 2017 and down \$3.00 from January a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during February 2018 totaled 861 million pounds, up 0.3 percent from February 2017. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in January 2018, at \$17.00 per hundredweight, is down \$1.20 from December 2017 and down \$3.00 from January a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during February 2018 totaled 208 million pounds, down 1.9 percent from February 2017. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in January 2018, at \$16.90 per hundredweight, is down \$1.20 from December 2017 and down \$3.20 from January a year ago.
