Milk production in **New York** during December 2019 totaled 1.27 billion pounds, up 1.9 percent from December 2018. The average milk price received by New York farmers in November 2019, at \$20.50 per hundredweight, is up \$0.80 from October 2019 and up \$2.70 from November a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during December 2019 totaled 843 million pounds, down 1.5 percent from December 2018. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in November 2019, at \$21.00 per hundredweight, is up \$0.90 from October 2019 and up \$3.00 from November a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during December 2019 totaled 224 million pounds, down 0.4 percent from December 2018. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in November 2019, at \$20.90 per hundredweight, is up \$0.90 from October 2019 and up \$2.70 from November a year ago.
