Milk production in **New York** during March 2020 totaled 1.32 billion pounds, up 2.1 percent from March 2019. The average milk price received by New York farmers in February 2020, at \$19.10 per hundredweight, is down \$0.70 from January 2020 but up 1.40 from February a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during March 2020 totaled 907 million pounds, up 2.0 percent from March 2019. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in February 2020, at \$19.40 per hundredweight, is down \$0.80 from January 2019 but up 1.50 from February a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during March 2020 totaled 232 million pounds, down 0.9 percent from March 2019. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in February 2020, at \$19.60 per hundredweight, is down \$0.70 from January 2019 but up 1.50 from February a year ago.
