Massachusetts Cranberry Production Forecast Up from 2020

CONCORD, NH --- Massachusetts 2021 cranberry production is forecast at 2.10 million barrels, up 2% from 2020 production, according to Pam Hird, State Statistician of the USDA’s National Agricultural Statistics Service, New England Field Office.

United States 2021 total cranberry production is forecast at 7.90 million barrels, up 1% from 2020 .

Wisconsin production is forecast at 4.70 million barrels, up 1% from last year.
