Milk production in **New York** during April 2021 totaled 1.31 billion pounds, up 2.2 percent from April 2020. The average milk price received by New York farmers in March 2021, at \$17.90 per hundredweight, is up \$0.50 from February 2021 but down \$0.60 from March a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during April 2021 totaled 874 million pounds, down 1.0 percent from April 2020. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in March 2021, at \$17.90 per hundredweight, is up \$0.50 from February 2021 but down \$1.00 from March a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during April 2021 totaled 217 million pounds, down 2.7 percent from April 2020. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in March 2021, at \$18.10 per hundredweight, is up \$0.20 from February 2021 but down \$0.90 from March a year ago.
