Milk production in **New York** during February 2022 totaled 1,184 million pounds, down 0.8 percent from February 2021. The average milk price received by New York farmers in January 2022, at \$24.70 per hundredweight, is up \$2.70 from December 2021 but up \$7.60 from January a year ago.

Milk production in **Pennsylvania** during February 2022 totaled 791 million pounds, down 0.9 percent from February 2021. The average milk price received by Pennsylvania farmers in January 2022, at \$24.80 per hundredweight, is up \$2.50 from December 2021 but up \$7.50 from January a year ago.

Milk production in **Vermont** during February 2022 totaled 199 million pounds, down 0.5 percent from February 2021. The average milk price received by Vermont farmers in January 2022, at \$25.20 per hundredweight, is up \$2.50 from December 2021 but up \$7.40 from January a year ago.
