Cranberry Highlights

New Jersey 2023 cranberry crop forecast at 550 thousand barrels

New Jersey cranberry producers expect to harvest 550 thousand barrels in 2023, compared to 563 thousand barrels in 2022, according to Bruce Eklund, New Jersey State Statistician.

In Wisconsin, the largest growing State, production is forecast at 4.60 million barrels, down 5% from last year. Production in Massachusetts, forecast at 2.00 million barrels, is down 12% from last year. Oregon producers expect to harvest 470 thousand barrels, up from 400 thousand barrels in 2022.

Cranberry growers experienced cold temperatures, with below-normal precipitation and above-normal snowfall during the winter months.

United States cranberry total production for the 2023 season is forecast at 7.62 million barrels, down 5% from the 2022 crop year.
