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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, October 31, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 61 percent adequate and 39 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 83 percent adequate and 17 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 10 percent fair and 90 percent good.
