According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, October 16, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies 100 percent adequate. Subsoil moisture supplies were 100 percent adequate. Pasture conditions were 15 percent poor, 33 percent fair and 52 percent good.
