According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New Jersey, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 23, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 59 percent adequate and 41 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 97 percent adequate and 3 percent surplus. Pasture conditions were 2 percent fair and 98 percent good.
