New Jersey 2014 Annual Milk Production Unchanged from 2013

The annual production of milk for New Jersey during 2014 was 127 million pounds, unchanged from 2013, according to Bruce Eklund, State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New Jersey Field Office.

Production per cow in New Jersey averaged 18,143 pounds for 2014.

The average number of milk cows on farms in New Jersey during 2014 was 7,000 head, unchanged from 2013.
