New Jersey 2018 Annual Milk Production Down 7.6 Percent from 2017

TRENTON, NJ - The annual production of milk for New Jersey during 2018 was 110 million pounds, 7.6 percent below 2017, according to Bruce Eklund, State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New Jersey Field Office.

Production per cow in New Jersey averaged 18,333 pounds for 2018, 1,500 pounds below 2017.

The average number of milk cows on farms in New Jersey during 2018 was 6 thousand head, unchanged from 2017.
