


**PECANS:** Pecan production in New Mexico totaled 65 million pounds in 2012, a low bearing year in the alternate bearing cycle. Farmers received \$1.70 per pound on average for their pecans. Value of production totaled slightly over \$110.5 million, the second highest in the nation.
