## COTTON GINNINGS – 2014 CROP

### NEW MEXICO

New Mexico gins had processed 44,100 running bales (45,050 480-pound bales) of **all cotton** from the 2014 crop, compared with 39,000 running bales (40,050 480-pound bales) last year and also processed 9,350 running bales (9,600 480-pound bales) of **Pima** cotton.

### UNITED STATES

**United States** running bales of **all cotton** ginned from harvest in 2014 totaled 15.88 million running bales (16.29 million 480-pound bales), compared to 12.52 million running bales (12.87 million 480-pound bales) from the same period in 2013, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Of that, 15.33 million running bales (15.73 million 480-pound bales) were **upland** cotton and 544,900 running bales (565,550 480-pound bales) were **Pima** cotton.
