COTTON GINNINGS – FEBRUARY 1, 2016

NEW MEXICO

New Mexico gins had processed 33,050 running bales of **all cotton** by February 1, of which 14,250 running bales were **Pima** cotton, and 18,800 running bales were **upland** cotton.

UNITED STATES

By February 1, 2016, cotton gins throughout the United States had processed 12.3 million running bales of **all cotton**, compared to 15.5 million running bales from the same period in 2014, according to the Mountain Regional Field Office of the National Agricultural Statistics Service, USDA. Of that, 11.84 million running bales were **upland** cotton and 417,150 running bales were **Pima** cotton.
