APRIL - JUNE 2016 QUARTERLY MILK PRODUCTION MOUNTAIN REGION HIGHLIGHTS

Arizona dairy herds produced 1.29 billion pounds of milk during the April - June quarter, up 2.1 percent from the previous year.

Colorado dairy herds produced 965 million pounds of milk during the April - June quarter, up 2.2 percent from the previous year.

Montana dairy herds produced 75.0 million pounds of milk during the April - June quarter, down 2.6 percent from the previous year.

New Mexico dairy herds produced 1.97 billion pounds of milk during the April - June quarter, down 3.6 percent from the previous year.

Utah dairy herds produced 546 million pounds of milk during the April - June quarter, down 4.7 percent from the previous year.

Wyoming dairy herds produced 34.6 million pounds of milk during the April - June quarter, up 1.8 percent from the previous year.

UNITED STATES HIGHLIGHTS

Nationally, **U.S.** milk production during the April - June quarter totaled 54.4 billion pounds, up 1.2 percent from the April - June quarter last year.
