


POULTRY



The combined value of New York produced eggs and the value of sales for other chickens, was \$96.9 million for the year ending November 30, 2008.

Egg production in New York during the 2008 year totaled 1.17 billion, up 4 percent from a year earlier. Egg prices were higher, increasing from 78.7 cents in 2007 to 99.6 cents in 2008. The resulting total value of \$96.9 million was 31 percent above the 2007 egg production value of \$73.9 million.
