New York: Spring weather has finally arrived. Warmer, but below average temperatures were widely reported state wide. The state high temperature was 72 for both Rochester and Buffalo. The state low temperature was 17 for Elmira. Above average rainfall was recorded with the highest precipitation in Central Hudson Valley region. Major activities include spring pruning of fruit trees, tending livestock, and mending damaged fencing and machinery equipment. Maple tapping may be winding down across most of the state as temperatures climb into the high 60's and 70's.
