According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday; August 16th, 2020. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 33 percent short, 61 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 20 percent short, 73 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Pasture conditions ranged from 13 percent very poor, 15 percent poor, 32 percent fair, 34 percent good, and 6 percent excellent.
