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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 2.6 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday; April 18, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 11 percent short, 65 percent adequate, and 17 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 23 percent short, 58 percent adequate, and 13 percent surplus.
