According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 26, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 37 percent short, 52 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 13 percent short, 80 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus.
