According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 3.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 23, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 5 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 27 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 6 percent short, 81 percent adequate, and 13 percent surplus.
