According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, July 7, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 7 percent short, 79 percent adequate, and 14 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 6 percent short, 83 percent adequate, and 11 percent surplus.
