According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, August 4, 2024. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 16 percent short, 75 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 12 percent short, 82 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus.
