According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 3.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 20, 2025. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 6 percent short, 78 percent adequate, and 16 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 5 percent short, 84 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus.
