According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in New York, there were 4 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 27, 2025. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 2 percent short, 78 percent adequate, and 19 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 74 percent adequate, and 23 percent surplus.
