Cash Receipts of Meat Animals Increased 47 Percent in New York

ALBANY, NY – Total 2014 cash receipts from marketings of meat animals increased 47 percent to \$435 million, according to Blair Smith, State Statistician of USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, New York Field Office. Cattle and calves accounted for 95 percent of this total and hogs and pigs accounted for 5 percent.

Cash receipts from marketings of cattle and calves increased 49 percent from \$279 million in 2013 to \$415 million in 2014. All cattle and calf marketings totaled 255 million pounds in 2014, up 12 percent from 2013.

Cash receipts from hogs and pigs totaled \$20.6 million during 2014, up 15 percent from 2013. Marketings total 26.7 million pounds in 2014, up 2 percent from 2013.

The 2014 gross income from cattle and calves and hogs and pigs for New York totaled \$449 million, up 47 percent from 2013. Gross income for cattle and calves increased 49 percent, and hogs and pigs increased 18 percent from previous year's gross income.

Total 2014 production of cattle and calves and hogs and pigs for New York totaled 291 million pounds, down 4 percent from 2013. Production decreased 5 percent for cattle and calves, but increased 14 percent for hogs and pigs.
