NEW YORK ONION FORECAST

ALBANY, NY --- Production for New York's summer storage onions in 2015 is forecast at 2.31 million cwt, compared to 2.36 million cwt in 2014. Area for harvest is estimated at 6,900 acres, down from 8,000 acres in 2014. The expected is yield 335 cwt per acre, up from last year's yield of 295 cwt per acre.

The final value of New York's summer storage onion production for 2014 was \$33.8 million, up 7 percent from \$31.6 million in 2013.
